Courses

Registration:

You can register for up to 5 classes per semester. The orientation does not constitute one of the five classes. These classes don't include the mandatory orientation, CP 190, that you will take in the first two semesters of starting at BGSP. These tables are meant to be a guide, you can take each course with your own time.

Analysis:

Be sure to start analysis with a training analyst from BGSP, or outside BGSP as soon as you can if you plan on doing the fieldwork in your second semester. You need 12 hours of analysis to start your fieldwork experience. You need 70 hours of analysis in order to graduate from the program. It is up to you and the analyst to discuss how often you would like to meet. It is possible to start off with a biweekly schedule, or a weekly schedule. Be conscientious about timing if you plan to finish the degree within 2 years.

Fieldwork:

When you register for your first semester of fieldwork, you will apply for it with using the form that is in the fieldwork manual (available online). Make sure that you have completed 12 hours of analysis before applying and that you have taken the prerequisite courses (CP 101, CP 184 or CP 186 Psychopathology I or II depending on if you started in the spring or fall). Then you will sign up for your first semester of CP 185, the fieldwork seminar; you'll register for it for 3 semesters. Each semester of the fieldwork seminar you will write a paper: 1st semester, 8-10 pages; 2nd semester, 8-15 pages; 3rd semester, 20-25 pages. You will also register for CP 111 Group Supervision, for each semester of PT185 and for the summer. During the first semester of fieldwork you will also look for an individual supervisor, and you will register for 10 hours of CP 331. You will schedule your hours with the individual supervisor. They need to be an LMHC licensed for three years to be your supervisor.

Internship:

You apply for an internship with the internship coordinator, Dr. Soldz, or you can apply for your own. It is hard to find an internship that starts in the spring. You will register for the internship placement for two semesters, first CP 350 then CP 351. These are the internship individual supervisions. If you are part of the School Outreach Program, you will also register for CP 214 for two consecutive semesters. Additionally, if you are planning to do the School Outreach Program, you will sign up for the two children classes—one per semester. CP 188, the clinical work with children class, and CP 189 childhood psychopathology; each are 3 credits for those working with children, if taking it as an elective it is 2 credits.

Thesis (optional):

See your advisor if you wish to write a thesis in addition to the CP 185 papers.

Mental Health Counseling, M.A. - Fall Start:

If you're planning on finishing the program within two years this is how it'll look, if you start in the Fall. Make sure that you stay on top of applying to internships and the fieldwork if that is your plan.
