Immediate behavioral health crisis services available to your patients as an alternative to the emergency department

What is the Emergency Services Program?

Emergency Services Programs (ESPs) across Massachusetts provide **24/7/365 crisis assessment**, **intervention**, **and stabilization** services to individuals of all ages with mental health, substance use disorder, and/or co-occurring conditions. ESPs provide:



On-site, face-to-face therapeutic responses including short-term, solution-focused counseling



Psychiatric consultation and urgent psychopharmacology intervention, as needed



Referrals and linkages to all medically necessary behavioral health services and supports



Safety plans developed in collaboration with patients' behavioral health providers

Available ESP Services

- **Mobile Crisis Intervention (MCI) for youth:** For MassHealth-enrolled youth up to the age of 21 (and up to the age of 19 for some commercial insurance companies), this service mobilizes to the home, your office, or other site where a youth is located.
- **MCI for adults:** Provides services to adults, ages 21+ in their homes, residential programs, or wherever the patient is located including a hospital emergency department.
 - From 7 a.m. to 8 p.m., adult mobile services are available at any location, including your office.
 - From 8 p.m. to 7 a.m., this service is available in residential programs and EDs.
 - Some ESPs may provide additional hours for adult mobile services to all locations.
- **Community-based locations:** These locations are operated by the ESP, outside an ED. Operating hours for each location can be found in the ESP Directory at www.masspartnership.com/pdf/MBHPESPDirectory.pdf.
- **Community Crisis Stabilization:** This service provides a staff-secure, less-restrictive, and voluntary alternative to a psychiatric hospital for ages 18+.

How is it accessed?

The patient, a family member, or clinician can call the local ESP team using the contact information on the back of this flyer. If for some reason you or the patient don't have access to those numbers, call the statewide ESP number at **1-877-382-1609**. Enter the zip code of the location of the patient; the call will be automatically transferred to the closest crisis team.

Who can receive ESP services?

Services are available at no cost to individuals with MassHealth (Medicaid), Medicare, or who do not have insurance. Many ESPs also contract with commercial insurance companies. Call your local ESP team to learn more.

What's the benefit?

ESPs are an alternative to hospital emergency departments that provide **immediate**, **professional clinical support** for patients experiencing non-life-threatening behavioral health crises. Learn more at www.masspartnership.com/provider/esp.aspx.
